ASEAN’s relations with China have been undergoing significant changes in recent years. As a distinguished diplomat and scholar, Ambassador Chan is superbly qualified to help Americans understand the implications of these developments.

Her Excellency Chan Heng Chee took up her appointment as Singapore’s Ambassador to the United States in July 1996. Prior to her appointment, she was the Executive Director of the Singapore International Foundation and Director of the Institute of Southeast Asian Studies. She was educated at the University of Singapore and Cornell University. Ambassador Chan has published numerous articles and books on politics in Singapore, Southeast Asia and International Security.
