Fujian Province

Located along China's southeastern coast, across from Taiwan, Fujian province has a population of 35 million. Since 1978, Fujian has sustained a high rate of economic growth and attracted investments from over 100 countries, and leading multinational corporations such as Dell, Wal-Mart, GE, BP, Exxon Mobile, TOYOTA, Mitsubishi, and Maersk Logistics - to name but a few. At present, there are 1,360 American investment projects in Fujian, involving an investment of US\$4.2 billion. Fujian's pillar industries include information technology, mechanical parts and oil and chemical engineering. During recent years, tourism, biological and food industries are also growing rapidly.

Baltimore's sister city in China, Xiamen, is part of Fujian province.
